## Important Note

A boat should only be put in the boat park once your request for a space has been approved.

The Boat park fee's cover a 12 month Period starting from the 1<sup>st</sup> of April, if at your application for a boat park space has less than 3 months (after the 31<sup>st</sup> of December) to the renewal period then a 50% discount will apply.

Boats are stored entirely at owners' risk, and neither the Club nor its Officers or servants (whether employed or voluntary) will accept any liability for loss or damage, however caused. In particular, the Club takes no responsibility for providing or ensuring either site security or any other security for boats stored in the compound.

It is the responsibility of the boat owner to supply and fit suitable ground anchors and ties or wheel chocks.

Paragraph 1A-8 (c) of the LSC Sailing Handbook, requiring boats launching or making a passage from the Club to be covered by Third Party Insurance, shall apply at all times when boats are on the club premises, whether afloat or not, and this requirement remains in force for all boats stored in the Boat Park.

## Boat Park Bylaws

If at any time any berthing fees or subscriptions payable to the club by any member or former member shall be three months or more in arrears:

(a) The committee shall be entitled to move the boat to any other part of the premises without being liable for any loss or damage to the boat howsoever caused.

(b) The committee shall be entitled upon giving one month's notice in writing to the member or former member, at his last known address shown in the register of members, to sell the boat and to deduct any monies due to the club (whether by way of arrears of subscription or mooring or berthing fees or otherwise) from the net proceeds of sale before accounting for the balance (if any) to the member or former member.

(c) Alternatively any boat which in the opinion of the committee cannot be sold may, upon such notice as aforesaid, be disposed of in any manner the committee may think fit and the expenses recovered from the member or former member. Any arrears as aforesaid shall be deemed to be a debt owing to the club by the member or former member.

(d) Further the club shall, at all times, have a lien over members' or former members' boats parked or moored on the club's premises or club moorings in respect of all monies due to the club, whether in respect of arrears of mooring fees or subscriptions or otherwise.

(e) All boats while stored on the boat park or in the club grounds shall be covered by 3<sup>rd</sup> party insurance for a minimum of £2,000,000.

(f) All boats 1 metric tonne or less are required to be anchored to the ground while stored in the boat park, boats over 1 metric tonne are required to have the wheels on the trailers chocked while stored in the boat park.

- **The purpose of the Boat Park is to provide storage for boats in regular use. It is not provided as a storage facility for boats not in use.**
- Each berth in the Boat Park is normally conditional upon the boat being used regularly.
- Annual renewal of a berth may be declined if the boat has not been in regular use the previous year.
- For new applications for a berth there is no requirement for use in the previous year, but we will expect an indication of the intention to use the boat regularly.
- The Committee will consider extenuating circumstances if for good reason a boat cannot meet the usage requirement.
- Berths for boats not meeting the above usage conditions will be at the sole discretion of the General Committee.
