Tugboat Hitch, a.k.a. Bollard Hitch, a.k.a. Lighterman's Hitch

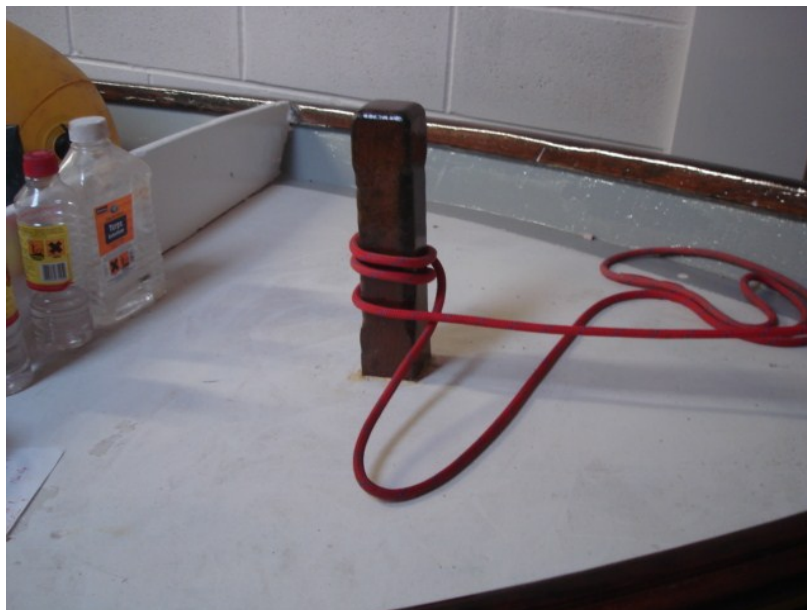
- Quick and easy to apply
